### DO NOT BRING:

- Money (see Trading Post Account)
- Knives, other weapons, or fireworks
- Jewelry, glass items, hair dryers, etc...
- Soda-pop, candy, gum, snacks (they bring critters)
- Radios, CD/MP3 players, iPods, electronic games, cell phones

**\*\*\*Medications.** State law requires that ALL medication/vitamins brought to camp must be in their original container, be clearly labeled, and include written instructions from the prescribing physician for their use. All medication will be kept locked in the Health lodge. Our Health Staff are responsible for giving out medications.
